Wholesale and Contract Grow Pricing

We offer a 15% discount on wholesale available plant stock and a 30% discount on contract grow orders. Not all species are available in all sizes due to individual timing and potting requirements.

Deposit

25% will be required to start your order, with payment in full due at plant pickup.





Minimum Order

We require a minimum order of 75 plants for contract growing. Wholesale orders of existing plants have a minimum of 25 plants.

Readiness Time

Plants are subject to the whims of nature and inherent eccentricities of native seed. Every effort will be made to provide the client with an accurate readiness time. OVLC Nursery staff will advise clients immediately of any changes or adjustments to quantity or timing of the order.

Attrition/Crop Failure

Though unlikely, crop failure or major attrition is always a possibility when growing native plants. If we are unable to completely fill your order, we will refund the appropriate amount of the deposit. You will be notified immediately if we are not going to be able to fulfill the order.

Late Pickups

Customer is responsible for picking up plants within an agreed upon time frame, in coordination with OVLC's Native Plant Specialist. Extending past the designated pickup date will incur a fee of \$.50/plant/week.

Payment method

Check is preferred, a 2.5% surcharge will be added to all credit card payments.

Sales Tax

CA state and local sales tax will be added to your order.
